# Awareness and regulation of feelings

Over the years I have realized that many of the younger children in elementary school don't have the words to express their feelings. In addition, they are not aware of the feelings that can naturally arise over the course of the day. Even as adults, we can experience our emotions going from zero to sixty when we are cut off by another car driving through heavy traffic. Fortunately, most adults have developed some regulation strategies to help us handle our emotions in these stressful situations. This month our staff will focus on helping students with feeling their emotions and then developing strategies to help them regulate or balance their emotions. As parents we can help our children by being good models by labeling our emotions and demonstrating the strategies that you use to regulate your emotions. For example, if you are cut off by a driver when your kids are in your car, you can express your anger and say, "I am so angry" and then model some deep breathing or other strategy. Parents and loved ones modeling small moments such as these can strongly reinforce the lessons that we are teaching them at school.



#### **School Advisory Council**



## **Morning Drop Off**


Please remember that children cannot be dropped off at school in the morning until 8:35 am, as we do not have outside supervision until then. If your child is eating breakfast at the school, they can be dropped off at 8:20 am when breakfast starts. Also, if your child is tardy or late in the morning, please walk with them into the office and sign them in. One last thing: when dropping your child/children off in the drop off line in the morning, if possible, please avoid having your child get out of your vehicle on the left side, as sometimes cars buzz around cars that are parked and/or letting their children out. Thank you for your help and cooperation in keeping our children at Scenic safe.



#### Milk

For the past two years a hot lunch in the cafeteria has been free. There have been many students who have transitioned to bringing a lunch box to school. However, many of these students are also asking for milk from the cafeteria. The staff can't tell students they can't have any milk, but their parents are being charged for the milk. If you do not want your child to have milk in the cafeteria, please let them know. To see if your child has been charging milk on their account, please go to the D51 website and go to the Parents Tab - Parent Tools - My Payments Plus. You will need to create an account and then go under Cafeteria Accounts to add funds or check their meal purchases. Students who do not qualify for meal benefits will pay \$2.25 for elementary breakfast and \$3.25 for elementary lunch. Extra milk or milk purchased without purchasing a meal is .90 cents.
